Nursery

Nursery children have had a great start to the year and settled in really well. They have enjoyed reading a range of stories and have explored lots of different shapes. We have started Writedance and Dough Gym, both activities which help develop fine motor skills. After the Half Term break, we will be having a themed week on Halloween where we will be looking at light and dark. Nursery children will be able to dress up and play with Halloween props and make potions. Have a great break and please read daily with your child.

Reception

This week we are learning about different shapes and how to describe them. We are identifying straight and curved edges. See if you can help your child find straight and curved edges around your home. We have read "Funnybones" and are learning about our skeleton. Instead of being something scary, we are learning that our skeleton helps and protects us! It has been a great first Half Term for your children and they have settled in very well. Enjoy lots of park time and stories over the Half Term holiday!

Year 1

This week we visited the Institute of Physics where we found out all about what goes on in an office. We have used this as a stimulus to write from in English. In Maths, we started breaking whole numbers into parts to write simple addition number sentences. During Half Term, don't forget to visit the library on Blackstock Road to help your child listen to and enjoy story books!

Year 2

What a wonderful end to a busy Half Term. This week the children have wowed everyone with their amazing story writing - please encourage them to keep it up over the half term. We have all enjoyed the calmness that has come from our handwriting sessions and found even more peace when we got back to nature on Monday, planting tulips in the front garden of the school. In Computing, we have been learning to save and edit files which has been challenging as there are lots of steps to remember. Well done to all of the children for embracing the challenges in Year 2. We can't wait for you to impress us with even more brilliant learning about wild weather next Half Term!

Year3/4

This week Years 3 & 4 have started exploring addition in Maths. Homework has been set on Mathletics, where you can aid your child in their Maths learning. In Literacy, we have been learning all about our topic "Romans". We have imagined that we are Roman Citizens applying to be Roman Soldiers. Ask us about some of the many interesting facts we have learnt. Have a fantastic Half Term and remember to read every day.

Year 5
