#### **Nursery/Reception**

This week we have been telling the story of The Three Little Pigs, thinking about the different characters in the story and about how they are feeling. We have learned about 'zero' and "number bonds" to five, exploring different ways to make the number five. We continue to welcome new children to the classes and are remembering how to be a good and kind friend.

#### Year 1

In Literacy this week, we are learning to retell the story of Rapunzel, using fairy tale language and relevant adjectives. In Maths, we are using our knowledge of number bonds to 10 and partitioning numbers, to help us do addition and subtraction, crossing 10. We are also learning about how to be safe on the Internet and who our safe person is that we can trust if we want to share a secret. Since our theme is on Castle, we have learnt to identify castles that we can find around the United Kingdom and we are creating our own crown.

#### Year 2

This week in Literacy, we have been learning our new story "Chocolate Planet". We have been explaining our favourite parts of the story using conjunctions. In Maths, we have been representing multiplication as arrays and as number lines. Lastly, we have begun looking at the Mayans and the history of chocolate which has been fun!

#### Year 3/4

In Literacy this week, we have been writing a formal letter to a character in the film we have been studying called The Lucky Dip. In Maths, we have been continuing our work on multiplication and in Topic, we have been learning about tectonic plates. In Science, we have been learning about the properties of gases and in Spanish we have been learning about colours. Please ensure that all trip letters are brought back to school by Monday to ensure that your child can attend the trip on Tuesday 28th. We have given out replacement letters for those children who have misplaced them.

#### Year 5

This week we have been honing our legend writing skills ready to create our own versions. In Maths, we have been converting between improper fractions and mixed numbers. Please practise more on Mathletics or review on Maths Antics, as it is challenging!

#### Year 6

This week Year 6 have continued to learn about measurement in Maths, we have been working together to solve reasoning problems linked to volume and area. We have also written letters to send to the head of Sainsbury's, urging him to consider immediate action to limit the impact of plastic, as our topic this half term is Sustainability.
