Nursery

We welcome Nursery and Reception back to school with looking at what it means to be kind. We are celebrating kindness through our actions with our friends and people around us. We are also learning how to be good friends with each other. We are learning to add using part/whole method and using symbols.

Year 1

In Literacy, we are looking at the story 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. Children have learnt the story by heart and can act it out. We have also been discussing how they think the characters feel at different points of the story. In Maths, we are extending our number knowledge to 50! We can now count and represent numbers up to 50. We have been learning about countries in Europe and tasted picnic food from some of the countries!

Year 2

Welcome back! We have had a great start to our term by making pancakes, taking part in the Pooles Park Premier Pancake Projector competition and learning about why Christians eat pancakes on Shrove Tuesday. In English, we have written instructions explaining how to make pancakes and in Maths we have been revisiting 2d and 3d shapes, and building on our knowledge by describing their properties, using Mathematical vocabulary - faces, vertex (vertices) and edges. Reminder - sadly, we already have some missing jumpers, so please make sure each item of uniform has your child's name on it.

Year 3/4

This week Year 3 & 4 have continued studying sugarcane juice in Literacy. Year 4 have started fractions in Maths. Could both Year 3 & 4 please practise identifying different fractions at home and continue learning and practising times tables. Year 4 have a trip next Tuesday, so please bring back permission slips. Have a lovely weekend!

Year 5

Welcome back! We have been really impressed with the results of the holiday homework and we are ready for our Topic to be invaded by Vikings! This week another group of children have been braving the weather to do Bikeability.

Year 6

Year 6 have got off to a roaring start this half term. We have begun our new topic of Algebra in Maths and have enjoyed experimenting with equations. In English, we have begun exploring biographies and identifying common features so we too can write our own biography about the famous Scientist- James Watt. This is in relation to our new topic this half term of the Industrial Revolution. Homework this week includes researching our new topic along with some fractions revision.
