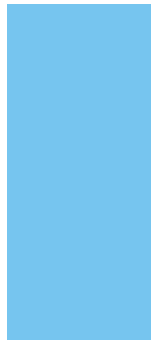

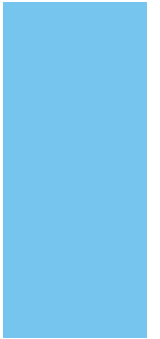

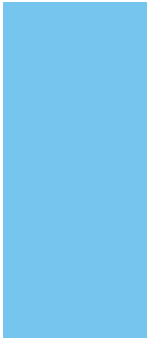

PE Kit

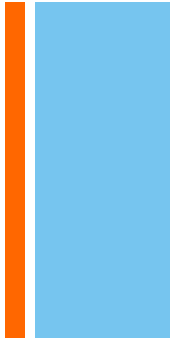

+ Reading at home



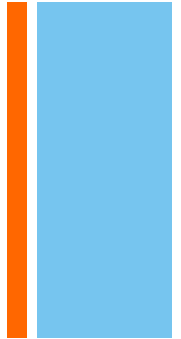
- Children all have a home reading journal.

+ Home Learning



- Children all have home learning set on Seesaw every Wednesday.
- It is due in no later than the following Wednesday.
- A record of children completing homework is kept.
- If a child knows they are unable to complete their Mathematics at home due to no internet etc. they should let their teacher know with a note from an adult.
- Children should know all their times tables by Year 5. If your child doesn't, please find 10 minutes a day to practice with them.

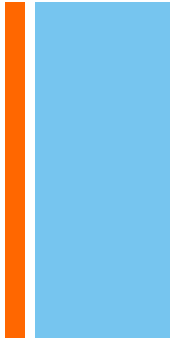

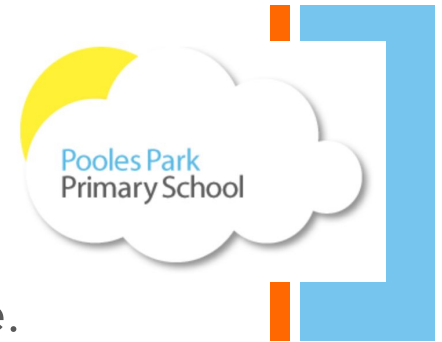
