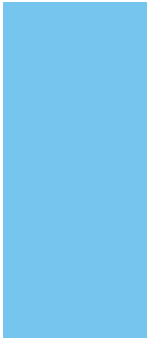

PE Kit

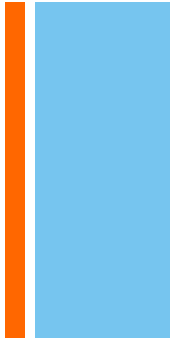
- Grey or black jogging bottoms (no leggings)

+ Reading at home



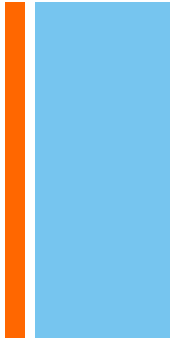
- Children all have a home reading journal.

- Children should read on their own or with parents for 20-60 minutes each night
- Complete reading journals at home and bring them every day.

+ Home Learning



- Children all have homework set on Seesaw every Wednesday.
- It is due in no later than the following Wednesday.
- A record of children completing homework is kept.
- If a child knows they are unable to complete their online learning at home due to no internet etc. they should let their teacher know with a note from an adult.
- Children should know all their times tables by Year 6. If your child doesn't, please find 10 minutes a day to practice with them. They are set times tables practice on TT Rockstars.

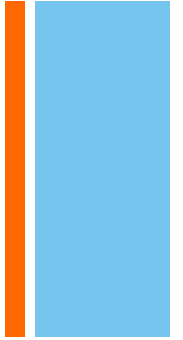

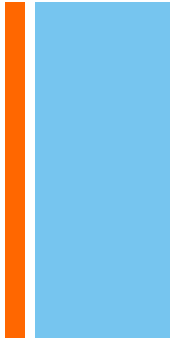
