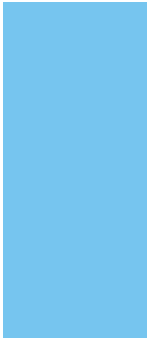

+ Reading at home



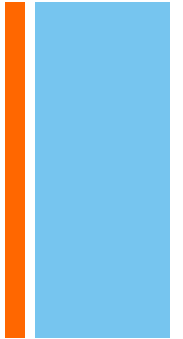
- Children all have a home reading diary.

Homework

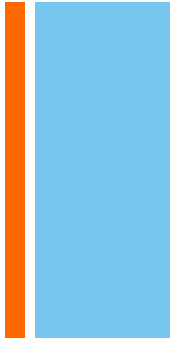


+ Home Learning

- A record of children completing homework is kept.

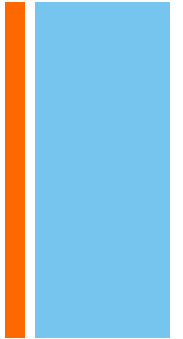

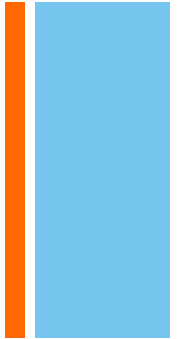
